In case you fall in love with scuba diving (wish you surely will), you will receive a **PADI** certificate of international participation after the dive, which will count as credit if you choose to later become Open Water Dive certified.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

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| SEASON | All year. Dec – May: sunny, warm, calm seas, better visibility, a bit less marine life July – Oct: cloudy, cooler, often choppy seas, worse visibility, more marine life June and November: transitional periods |
| WATER TEMPERATURE | The waters of the Galapagos Islands are a unique mixture of warm and cold water, ranging between 61°F and 75°F (16 – 24°C). |
| VISIBILITY | Usually ranges between 16 and 85 feet (5 - 25 m), but most often is between 40 and 60 feet (12 - 18 m) |
| AVERAGE AIR TEMPERATURES | December to May: 80°F to 90°F / 25°C to 30°C. June to September: 60°F to 70°F / 15°C to 20°C. October to December: 70°F to 80°F / 15°C to 25°C. |
